Celebrates its second century of uninterrupted service, we continue to strengthen the foundations of our community by focusing on youth development, healthy living and social responsibility.



We serve:

- More than 12,000 members at 2 branches
- 1,000 kids at 17 after school programs
- 250 Preschoolers at two preschools and a full-day childcare center
- 1,100 children at 4 camp locations
- 400 seniors at YMCA North Hunterdon Senior Center
- Currently, the Hunterdon County YMCA is awarding nearly \$315,000 in direct financial assistance to more than 2,100 residents throughout the county.
- In addition to this direct financial assistance, the Y subsidizes many significant programs for youth, teens and seniors.
- The Hunterdon County YMCA offers all county seventh graders with a complimentary one-year membership. Seventh grade has proven to be an important time to develop life-long healthy habits.
- The Y provides special programs for those with specific health needs, including LIVESTRONG at the YMCA for cancer survivors, a YMCA Diabetes Prevention Program, and Arthritis Aquacize.
