Enrollment

Clinton YMCA Preschool is open to children of appropriate age regardless of race, color, religion, ethnic, or national origin.

YMCA Program Membership is required to enroll.

Enrollment is secured with a one month's tuition deposit, registration fee, and YMCA Membership.

These fees are non-refundable.

Registration

Registration is on a first-come, first served basis beginning in February for the following school year.

Registration after the start of the school year is on a space-available basis.

We encourage you to visit and tour our facilities prior to registration.

On My Own-2½ Year Olds

Our caring, attentive staff is dedicated to providing our youngest preschoolers a smooth transition from the home environment to a group situation. We emphasize fun to encourage and promote a foundation for a positive learning experience. Children must be 2½ years old by Sept. 1st.

Class meets one OR two days per week
Tuesday AND/OR Thursday 9:15-11:15 am
1 Day \$98
2 Days \$155

Preschool - 3 Year Olds

Our three year olds are encouraged to develop independence, socialize, and participate in a group setting. Children learn to make choices, to take initiative, to form social connections and to make friends. Three year olds are natural learners who thrive in an environment rich in hands-on learning and opportunities for self-discovery. Children must be 3 years old by October 1st and toilet-trained.

Class meets two days per week OR three days per week
Tuesday AND Thursday 9:00-11:30 am \$173 per month
Tuesday AND Thursday 9:00-1:00 pm \$238 per month
Monday, Wednesday, Friday 9:00-12:00 \$265 per month

Preschool - 4 Year Olds

Four-Year Olds enter preschool with a wider range of experiences and are offered a more challenging program. Curriculum and structure prepare children for entering Kindergarten. Children are given the opportunity to grow socially, physically, intellectually, and emotionally through a stimulating, creative approach to learning. Children enrolled must be 4 years old by October 1st and toilet-trained.
