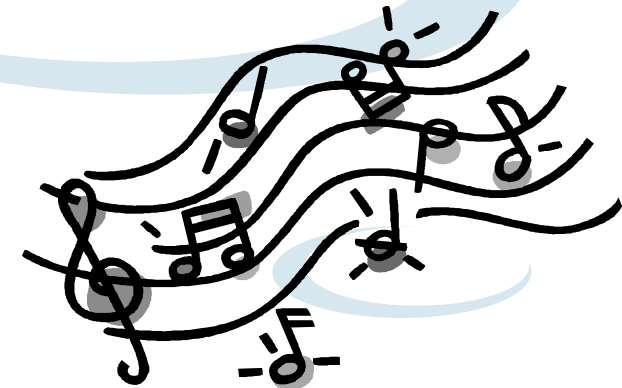

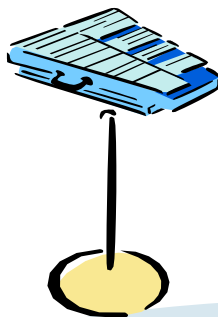

Music and Arts Camp July 13—17, 2009 Ages 7 to 12 yrs old

- Learning healthy vocal habits, developing listening and sight reading skills, refining rhythm, pitch accuracy, and experiencing various musical styles and languages.
- Performing challenging Orff instrumental ensembles (this includes playing instruments such as the metallophone, xylophone, glockenspiel, and other percussive instruments).
- Enjoying movement through various kinds of partner dancing.
- Creating arts and crafts relating to the various areas of music explored.

The last day of camp concludes with a performance for family and friends.
