onto your list.

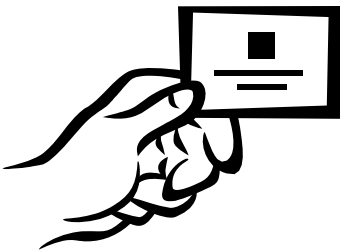

CELL PHONES

We understand that par-
ents want to be connected
to their children via cell
phone in an emergency
situation. For that reason
we are not banning the
carrying of a cell phone.
However we are request-
ing that they are not used

at camp and kept in their
backpack for an emer-
gency situation only.

If at anytime you need to
contact your camper you
need only call your camp
(numbers listed in this
newsletter). Whether

your child is at camp or on
a field trip we can contact
them through our Head
Counselors and or Leader-
ship staff, who all have
cell phones.

CELL PHONES CONTINUED...

If your child needs to contact you we will of course allow them use of either the camp phone or a Head Counselors cell phone.

In Travel Camp the Director may allow the use of cell phones so children can contact their parents informing them that they are almost back to camp or that they may be late from a retuning trip.

We appreciate your support.

DANGERS OF CAMPERS USING CELL PHONES:

- Calling people they should not be in contact with.
- Inappropriate pictures being taken and downloaded onto the internet. (CYBER-BULLYING)
- Not paying attention to infor-



mation being explained by counselors for their safety.

- Misinformation being provided to parents / guardians about important issues / situations at camp.

Cell phones that are used inappropriately will be confiscated for the day and returned only to the parent. Also the child's cell phone privileges may be revoked.

The YMCA is not responsible for lost, or damaged cell phones.

SNACK BAR CARDS

At Camp Carr and Sports Camp, we have snack bars. The main use of the snack bar is by children that attend After Care. The snack bar is open daily from 4:15-5:30 p.m. At least once a session, the children in main camp can visit the snack bar. Instead of sending your child to camp with money, it may be easier to have a snack bar card in place.

Snacks offered include items such as ice cream, crackers, chips, pretzels, candy, juice, and water. The cost of items ranges from \$.25 to \$1.25. If your child attends aftercare, we suggest that they have a \$10 card. If your child only attends main camp, no more than \$2 - \$5 is needed.
